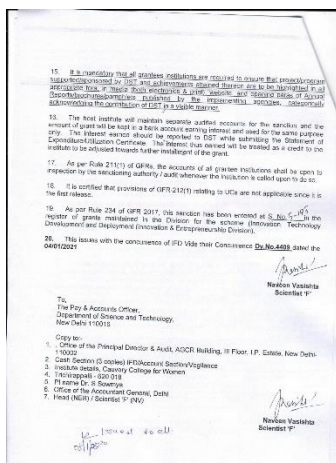
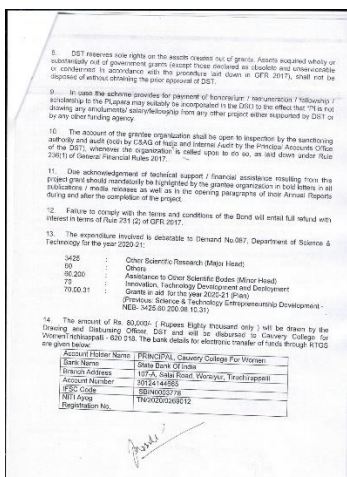

5. The grantee organization will have to enter & upload the Utilization Certificate in the PTMS portal besides sending it in physical form to this Division. The subsequent instalment will be released only after confirmation of the acceptance of the UC by the Division and entry of previous Utilization Certificate in the PTMS.

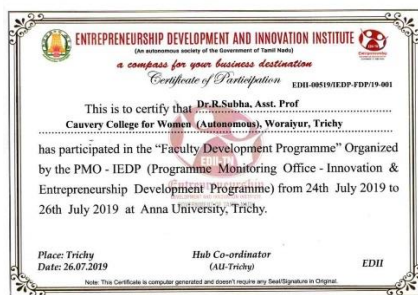
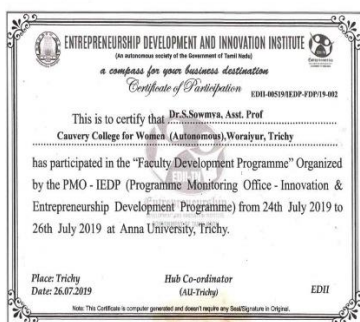
6. If the grant has been released under capital head through separate sanction order under the same project for purchase of equipments, separate SEUC has to be furnished for the release of capital head grant.

7. The grant-in-aid being released is subject to the condition that:

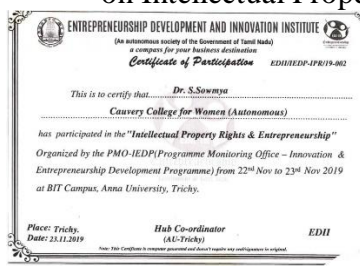
- The goods (consumable / equipments) available in Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal (https://www.gem.gov.in) are to be purchased mandatorily unless through GeM only required to be purchased under the project. The details list of the items which are procured in bulk regularly and are not available in GeM, may be furnished to DST at the earliest so that the matter may be taken up with GeM for its inclusion in the list of items available in GeM portal.
- A transparent procurement procedure in line with the Provisions of General Financial Rules 2017 will be followed by the Institute/Organization under the appropriate rules of the grantee organization while procuring capital assets sanctioned for the above mentioned project and a certificate to this effect will be furnished by the grantee organization immediately on receipt of the grant.
- The grantee institution may purchase the consumable and equipments through Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal (https://www.geem.gov.in).
- While submitting Utilization Certificate/Statement of Expenditure, the organization has to submit submission of supporting documentary evidences with regard to purchase of equipment/fund assets as per the provisions of GFR 2017. Subsequent release of grants under the project shall be considered only on receipt of the said documents.
- The grantee organization will maintain separate audited account for the project and the entire amount of grant will be kept in an interest bearing bank account. FY Grants released during FY. 2018-19 and onwards, all interests and other earnings, against released grant shall be transferred to Consolidated Fund of India (www.budget.gov.in) immediately after realization of accounts, as it shall not be allowed towards future release of grant account. A certificate to this effect shall have to be submitted along with Statement of Expenditure/Utilization Certificate for considering subsequent release of grant/fund of grant account.
- "Continuation of the Project beyond 31/03/2021 will be subject to appraisal and approval of the Umbrella Scheme under which the project is funded".
