CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING HELD ON 06.06.2019

The Member Secretary Dr Sinthu Janita Prakash read the minutes of the I Academic Council comprising the 20 Resolutions - The Resolution 01/01 to Resolution 01/20 of the I Academic Council Meeting in connection with Admission Regulations, Introduction of Outcome based Education under CBCS, Approval of Program Structure And Syllabi of I and II semesters, Regulations regarding the conduct, the valuation and publication of results for 2019-20 batch and onwards for all the Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Research programmes which were implemented.

The following suggestions given by the I Academic Council were also implemented

- In the duration of the programme, instead of 450 teaching clock hours the term 450 teaching periods can be given.
- To design Graduate Attributes.
- Credits to be matched with hours in all the programmes.
- Google class room can be given for presenting seminars.
- ICT tools for teaching, learning and assessment like Moodle, Google Class Room, Socrative Platform, Edmodo, Kahoot can be used.
- Curriculum should incorporate Communication, Collaboration, Creativity and Critical Thinking.
- For candidates with shortage of attendance, below 50% of attendance, they may be permitted to attend extra days, produce required attendance and appear for supplementary examination, on demand.
- Instant Examinations will be permitted in the final semester for two papers irrespective of any semester. Within a period of one month, instant examinations have to be conducted. Malpractice papers if any will not be considered for instant Examinations.
- In the Internal components, seminars could be included for UG courses, also attendance mark could be distributed in other components for both UG & PG.
- A template for Question paper setting to be developed and sent to the question paper setter. Questions to be taken with uniform distribution covering all units.
- Transparency / Retotalling / Revaluation is allowed for any number of theory papers
- A provision for withdrawal from End Semester Examinations to be given for valid reasons like representation of the Institution in curricular and co-curricular activities. For such candidates, next appearance should not be treated as arrears.

Few of the Suggestions given below are taken for further discussion in the present Academic Council meeting

- Extra credits courses can be offered to advanced learners. 140 credits as stipulated by the university, not exceeding 150 credits could be followed. The extra credits will not be included in CGPA calculation but will be mentioned in the mark statement issued by the college.

- Industries like TCS and Infosys under Corporate Social Responsibility will design the curriculum, train and recruit students. Such industries could be invited.
- Credit transfer for SWAYAM, NPTEL or any other equivalent body can be incorporated as extra credits
- Life Skills Training can be given in VI semester with extra credits.
- Track system to be followed for advanced learners.
- Soft Skills training can be given in every semester by external trainee.
- In Choice Based Credit System, choice can be given for selecting a teacher with a maximum student strength of 60.

The members jointly agreed to approve the Minutes of the Academic Council dt 06.06.2019.

In these courses if a student fails in the Examinations conducted by SWAYAM or any other equivalent body, a supplementary exam can be conducted by the CoE of the college.
