During the Academic council meeting, the members had suggested the following points.

1. In the duration of the programme, instead of 450 teaching clock hours the term 450 teaching periods can be given.
2. To design graduate attributes.
3. Google class room can be given for presenting seminars.
4. Credit transfer for SWAYAM, NPTEL or any other equivalent body can be incorporated as extra credits.
5. Track system to be followed for advanced learners.
6. Credits to be matched with marks in all the programmes.
7. In Choice Based Credit System, choice can be given for selecting a teacher with a maximum student strength of 60.
8. ICT tools for teaching, learning and assessment like Moodle, Google Class Room, Socrative Platform, Edmodo, Udemy, Kahoot can be used.
9. Industries like TCS and Infosys under Corporate Social Responsibility will design the curriculum, train and recruit students. Such industries could be invited.
10. Curriculum should incorporate Communication, Collaboration, Creativity and Critical Thinking.
11. Soft Skills training can be given in every semester by external trainee.
12. Life Skills Training can be given in VI semester with extra credits.
13. Suggestions in connection with syllabi will be placed in the BoS of the respective departments for further implementation.

Suggestions given with regard to Examinations

1. Extra credits courses can be offered to advanced learners. 140 credits as stipulated by the university, not exceeding 150 credits could be followed. The extra credits will not be included in CGPA calculation but will be mentioned in the mark statement issued by the college.
2. In exceptional case, for candidates with shortage of attendance, below 50% of attendance beyond their control, they may be permitted to attend extra days, produce required attendance and appear for supplementary examination, on demand.
3. Instant Examinations will be permitted in the final semester for two papers irrespective of any semester. Within a period of one month, instant examinations have to be conducted. Students punished for malpractices will not be considered for instant examinations.
4. In the Internal components, seminars could be included for UG courses, also attendance mark could be distributed in other components for both UG & PG.

5. The question paper pattern for

UG:

Section A : Objective type questions for 20 marks (Questions of heterogeneous nature)

Section B : Descriptive with Internal choice 5x5=25 marks

Section C : Descriptive with open choice 3x10=30 marks

PG:

UG Question pattern could be followed with specification for Question paper setting as below:

Section A will include Questions of lower order thinking

Section B will include Questions of middle order thinking

Section C will include Questions of higher order thinking

6. A template for Question paper setting to be developed and sent to the question paper setter. Questions to be taken with uniform distribution covering all units.
7. No need for Moderation Board.
8. Transparency / Re-totalling / Revaluation is allowed for any number of theory papers on payment of prescribed fees.
9. A provision for withdrawal from End Semester Examinations to be given for valid reasons like representation of the Institution in curricular and co-curricular activities. For such candidates, next appearance should not be treated as arrears.

Eligibility: 10 + 2 pattern

For Admission :

A pass in the Higher Secondary Examination (10 + 2) (Academic / Vocational Stream) conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu; or an examination accepted as equivalent thereto by the Syndicate, subject to such conditions as may be prescribed therefor.

ANNEXURE B

Duration of a Programme

- The Programme is for a period of three years for UG and two years for PG
- Two Semesters viz. Odd and Even semesters
- Odd Semester shall be from Jun / Jul to Oct / Nov
- Even Semester shall be from Nov / Dec to Apr / May
- There shall be not less than 90 working days which shall comprise 450 teaching clock hours for each Semester
- Courses are offered in 15 teaching weeks with 30 hours per week and the remaining weeks are to be utilized for conduct of examinations and evaluation purposes

The CBCS System

- All Programmes are conducted through Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).
- It is an instructional package developed to suit the needs of students to keep pace with the developments in higher education and the quality assurance expected of it in the light of liberalization and globalization in higher education

Credits

- The term “Credit” refers to the weightage given to a Course, usually in relation to the instructional hours assigned to it
- The total minimum credits, required for completing a UG Programme is 140 and PG Programme is 90.

Outcome Based Education

- Outcome based education (OBE) is student-centered instruction model that focuses on measuring student performance through outcomes.
- Outcomes include knowledge, skills and attitudes.

Programme Educational Objectives (PEO)

Long term goals (5 years or more after graduation) describing expected achievements of graduates in their career.

Programme Outcomes (PO)

Short term outcomes (at the point of graduation) describing what students are expected to know and be able to perform.

Course Outcomes (CO)

Statements of a learning achievement on completion of the Course
