Faculty Feedback Analysis Report 2019-2020

90.1% of the faculty rated the Board of Studies as excellent for ensuring is current relevance of the programme offered.

Furthermore, 84.8% of the faculty members indicated that the Employability is prioritized in curriculum design and development, also receiving an excellent rating.

86.5% rated the Department level subject expert committee meetings, which review the syllabus as excellent.

83.6% found that the representation from business, industry & alumni in UG/PG Boards of Studies is beneficial for designing and improving the courses.

85.2% of the faculty respondents stated that the courses/syllabi maintain a good balance between theory and application.

Moreover, 88.9% expressed high satisfaction with the relevance and concurrence of the prescribed books, journals and other reference materials, stating that they adequately cover the entire syllabus. 90.1% of the faculty members agreed that the courses and syllabi enhance their interest knowledge and perspective in the subject area.

92.9% of the faculty confirmed that the college provides full freedom to adopt new teaching techniques/strategies such as group discussion, seminar presentations and learners participation.

In terms of assessment, 88.3% rated the freedom to implement new techniques / strategies of testing and assessment of students.

90.1% of the faculty responded that the curriculum motivates Research, Publications and projects. Additionally, 91.8% of the respondents noted that tests and examinations are conducted on time covering all syllabus units effectively.

83.6% of the respondents opined that the prescribed text books and reference are available in the library along with sufficient e-resources.

81.2 % rated the administration as teacher friendly and 92.4% believed that the college provides ample opportunities and support to faculty members to upgrade their skills and qualifications.


While 84.8% found that the ICT facilities in the college are adequate and satisfactory, only 51.2% reported that there is a separate space in the College Canteen for teachers, rating it as excellent. Furthermore 52.5% the respondents expressed high satisfaction with the cleanliness and maintenance of Toilets and Washrooms, while 52.2% rated the classrooms as clean and well maintained.








### Employer Feedback Analysis 2019-2020














































### Employer Feedback Analysis Report 2019-2020









































### **Alumnae Feedback Analysis Report**

Furthermore, 55-58% of the alumnae positive about the curriculum global relevance and its effectiveness in providing practical training opportunities.






















### Parents Feedback analysis Report
