



#### **Students Feedback Report**

#### 2020-2021

Feedback was collected from 4,085 students on various parameters, including the timely completion of the syllabus, discussion and interaction in class, clarity of expression, teaching competency, and class preparation. Other aspects evaluated were classroom management, the use of modern teaching aids, distribution of handouts, the availability of suitable references, Power Point presentations, and web resources. Students also provided feedback on the ease of access to resources, the friendly and helpful attitude of the faculty, prompt grading and distribution of test papers and assignments, regular and timely feedback on their performance, adherence to the assessment schedule, career guidance and counseling, as well as punctuality and regularity in teaching, learning, and evaluation. The total number of student respondents was 4,085.

## Faculty Feedback Analysis Report 2020-2021

80%-90% of the faculty expressed that the opportunities for academic freedom, curriculum development, administration, and evaluation in the college as good to excellent. However, concerns were raised about the objective measures used in the assessment and evaluation system concerning the courses.

90.1% of the faculty rated the Board of Studies as excellent for ensuring the current relevance of the programs offered. 84.8% of respondents felt that employability considerations are given significant weight in curriculum design and development, and rated this aspect as excellent. 86.5% rated the department-level subject expert committee meetings for reviewing the syllabus as excellent. Additionally, 83.6% found that representation from business, industry, and alumni in UG/PG Boards of Studies is helpful for designing and improving courses.

85.2% of the faculty respondents rated the balance between theory and application in the courses/syllabi as very good. 88.9% were highly satisfied with the relevance and updates of the books, journals, and other reference materials prescribed, noting that they cover the entire syllabus. 90.1% of the faculty stated that the courses and syllabi enhance their interest, knowledge, and perspective in the subject area. 92.9% of respondents felt that the college provides full freedom to adopt new teaching techniques and strategies, such as group discussions, seminar presentations, and learner participation.

88.3% rated the freedom to adopt new techniques and strategies for testing and assessment as excellent. 90.1% opined that the curriculum motivates research, publications, and projects. 91.8% mentioned that tests and examinations are conducted in a timely manner with proper coverage of all syllabus units, and rated this aspect as excellent. 83.6% found that the prescribed textbooks and references available in the library were excellent.

81.2% rated the administration as teacher-friendly. 92.4% rated the college's support and opportunities for faculty skill and qualification upgrades as excellent. 84.8% found the ICT facilities in the college to be adequate and satisfactory. 51.2% of the faculty rated the availability of a separate space in the college canteen for teachers as excellent.

52.5% were highly satisfied with the cleanliness and maintenance of toilets/washrooms, while 52.2% rated the cleanliness and maintenance of classrooms as excellent."


## Employer Feedback Report 2020-2021

67% rated the students as good in areas such as internship, field visits, guest lecturers, assignments, and seminar which are essential for the development of skills for employment and self employment.




