
- 39% of student respondents found that the curriculum ensures subject-specific knowledge of local, regional, national, and global development needs to be good.

- Most student respondents rated the curriculum as very good for developing the required competencies and fulfilling course outcomes.






- 60% expressed an excellent opinion regarding the periodic revision of the curriculum based on stakeholder suggestions.







- 67% of employers rated the curriculum as excellent for being relevant and meeting the requirements of society, with electives that offer technical education for employability.

  scope for developing technical, logical, and creative skills in graduates.






- 49% of alumnae were very satisfied with the curriculum develops required competencies and fulfils course outcomes.






- 46% rated the periodic revision of the curriculum based on suggestions from stakeholders as very good.




