can send their proposals for selection to the Bharathidasan University Entrepreneurship, Innovation and Career Hub (BECH) and get a seed money of 5 lakhs to implement their ideas. He clarified regarding the introduction of the courses from Swayam NPTEL platform as extra credit courses.

The Principal Dr. V. Sujatha explained the practical difficulty of inducing it in the curriculum due to Pandemic, and the inability to take over the same course in the next session.

Mr. K. Thiruneelakandan, Secretary of the College, explained the support given to the students who register for courses in Swayam NPTEL platform, by providing them bus facility to the exam centers and by reimbursing the fees of both the faculty members and Students who pass the Course as Toppers and with Elite+Gold and Elite+Silver.

- In order to improve computer skills, the II MSW students are given opportunities to opt for Data Analysis (P), Course Code : 22PCS3GEC1P as their General Elective Course for III semester for the academic year 2023-2024. Further in the III semester Discipline Specific Elective Course-III titled 'Computer Skills for Social Workers', Course Code: 22PSW3DSE3B was introduced for the II MSW students for the academic year 2023-2024.
- Internship, course code: 22USW4INT is introduced for the BSW students during the semester holidays after III semester for the academic year 2023-2024.
- Field work Practicum which is introduced from the first semester for the 2023-2024 batch onwards ie Field Work -1 (P) Course Code: 23USW1CC1P is designed in the form of skill Lab.

- The need for inviting the field Practitioners for the Filed work VIVA-VOCE is intimated to Controller of Examinations and Principal for the inclusion of field Practitioners in the list of External Examiners.
- In order to improve the communication skills of the Students, BSW students are given opportunities to opt for the course 'Presentation Skills', Course Code: 22UEN3GEC1 offered by the English Department as their General Elective Course in their III semester for the academic year 2023-2024. Further BSW students in the V Semester are given opportunities to opt for the course titled 'Academic Writing', Course Code : 19UEN5SBE2A and 'Public Speaking', Course code: 19UEN5SBE2A as their Skill Based Elective courses offered by English department.
- To improve the field Work Practicum and to enhance the curriculum at the National Level, an MOU has been signed with High Energy Batteries paving way for field work placements and for research collaboration. MOU with NIPM enabled students and teachers attend Seminars, intellectual discussions and forums organised by NIPM where they met field experts and industrial representatives for knowledge sharing. Further an MOU was signed with Carmel College (Autonomous), Mala, Kerala and initiatives were taken to conduct National level Conferences in collaboration. Dr.G.Mettilda Buvanewari, Associate Professor and Head and Dr.T.Amirtha Mary, Assistant Professor, department of Social Work, Cauvery College for women (Autonomous) acted as resource persons in National Level seminars organised at Carmel College (Autonomous), Mala, Kerala and the staff and students from Carmel College (Autonomous), Mala, Kerala took part in the International Conference organised by Department of Social Work, Cauvery College for women (Autonomous), Trichy during the academic year 2023-2024.
- As there is a Placement Cell functioning in the College and a staff in charge acting at the department level, campus interviews have been conducted at regular intervals in the college. A campus interview was conducted on 6th April, 2023 by Cauvery Hospitals, Trichy for both UG and PG final year students for the academic year 2023-2024
- Alumnae meet is organised every year by the Dean of Alumnae relations Dr.G.Kanaga and the department has taken initiatives to organise programmes involving alumnae every year.
