5. Grievance Redressal Mechanism

Grievance cell consists of Management, Principal, Vice Principal and all HODs as a Committee and Physical Directress as Coordinator.

From this year, Heads of the departments are assigned floor wise incharges to take care of infrastructural grievances. Students can report to the floor incharges and they record it and report to the Physical Directress. She then discusses with the Principal and appropriate actions are taken with the approval of Management.

6. Tutor Ward System

To inculcate character-building, *Life-training* and man-making education more effectively Tutor Ward system was introduced this year. **Self-reform** and **Self-culture** which are the anchors of our ancient education are relegated to the background. Every tutor is assigned twenty five students. The tutor keeps record of the student's progress and if required, the student is given counselling.

Every Friday, the last hour is allocated for the interaction between the tutor and the wards. Socially relevant themes like Parental love, Importance of Mother, Love, Examination Ethics and Reality were discussed.

7 Student Evaluation of Teacher

The quality of teaching lies in the hands of qualitative teaching. Teaching includes exhaustive study of intensive matter. The teachers are assessed by the students using feedback form which is based on five point scale on various parameters required for teaching. The required correctional measures if any are given by the Principal.

8 Health Care

Our College has a unique and special mass health checkup Programme "To know your Health Step In" for all the first year students. Screening and detecting eye problems, protecting the oral hygiene of the students, assisting adolescent students with the support of gynecologist to deal with their respective issues were the proms conducted this year.

9 Women Study Centre

Our college is the first self financing college in the country to receive Rs 3,00,000 for establishing centre for Women Students under UGC XI plan.

- The Centre for Women Studies intend to extend special vocational training to the Women Self Help Groups with the view to prepare them as entrepreneur.
- The Centre for Women Studies would be focusing its attention towards young entrepreneurs to strengthen them with basic English course to compete with other entrepreneurs in the marketing field.
- Formation of Self Help Groups among economically backward and needy students and extending support by organizing Entrepreneurial Training Programme to sell their products inside the college campus.
- > Special Programmes would be organized on gender sensitization to enhance the attitude of gender equity and gender equality among students.
- The centre for Women Studies would also concentrate on adopted villages to sensitize the villages on gender issues and strengthen the Women Self Help Groups with more entrepreneurial skills.
- > Special Forum will be established among the students to discuss and deal with Women issues and to strengthen their capacity by organizing basic capacity building programmes.

The centre would also support the students by initiating in-house magazine to create an opportunity for them to express their views on various women issues and also to sensitize the society with greater awareness.

10 Extension Activities towards National Development

Apart from the department clubs we have various other clubs like Leo, Rotaract, ExNoRa, Blood Donors, Red Ribbon, Gender Club, Citizen Consumer Club. These clubs have done many community oriented programmes toward National development.

Kalaignar '86 Job fair

- Kalaignar '86 was a Job fair organized by Government of Tamil Nadu.
 Job Opportunity for unemployed youth in 8 constituencies in and around Trichy district between the age group of 18 30 was provided.
- Registration for the job fair took place from 23rd to 25th January 2010.
 Our College assisted the registration process in four constituencies namely Tiruchirappalli, Musiri, Lalgudi and Thottiyam by providing computers and also creating a database for 80,000 job aspirants.
 Orientation Programme for registered candidates took place on 9th February 2010
